From the Desk of the Secretary

I would like to thank those of you who took the time to bring our records up to date. As of now we have 59 members whose dues have not yet been recorded.

Membership consists of renewals, transfer demits, reinstatements and new members. While these numbers help us to grow, transfers out, death and delinquents cause our membership to decline. In order to keep a record of the growth and loss, we have created what we call a Magic Number. This number is arrived at by computing about a 12% loss every year. This means Palmetto Lodge's Magic Number is 70. After the Initiation in November, we will still need at least 39 more members to reach our Magic Number.

Everyone is on the Membership Committee and your Chairman is Barbara Bird. She has done an excellent job. Let's help Barbara out by bringing in new members and encouraging members that have not paid their dues to do so. Let us make the year 2007-2008 a banner year and watch our membership increase.
